Welcome To Boston Day 1: Arrivals and Introduction

Day 2: North of Boston Salem, Gloucester, Cape Ann and Newburyport

Salem MA, while known for its witches and Halloween culture, boasts some fabulous museums, ships and waterfront dining. Winding through the backstreets, we'll share historic properties and unparalleled views of the Atlantic. As we wind north through Gloucester, you will hear stories of maritime culture and meet local fisherman with national appeal. Gloucester and Cape Ann offer a variety of attractions, dining experiences and fabulous friends who love to share their stories.

Meet the team at the Gloucester Maritime Museum and learn about their in depth education program bringing the next generation of seafaring enthusiasts into the fold.

After a lovely day exploring the shores of Cape Ann, we will find our way to Newburyport. Situated on the mighty Merrimac River, this

quintessential New England town is quaint and inviting. As with many of the towns in the area, you'll experience the perfect combination of art, culture, dining and shopping.

Complete your Day 2 with a sunset dinner cruise along the Merrimac River. After a long day, your guide will escort you back to your hotel in Boston. This time, we'll pop down the highway so you can relax back in the comfort of your room!

Day 3: South of Boston Plymouth, New Bedford, Fall River

Plymouth, MA where it all started! Enjoy this gorgeous waterfront community and celebrate the culture of the indigenous and maritime history. Plymouth Pawtuxet boasts interactive experiences that span from the historic Grist Mill to the recently renovated Mayflower II. If time permits, we will showcase the living history museum so you can better understand the history of the first settlers.

Choice 1A After Plymouth Visit:

In addition to the famed Whaling Museum and Fishing Heritage Center, New Bedford is home to a magnificent fleet of active fishing vessels. We will introduce you to the culture through museums, attractions and gain first hand accounts from the people who are passionate story tellers. Home to a large Portuguese population, culinary choices are very diverse and range from rustic and casual to raw bars overlooking the waterfront.

Choice 1B After Plymouth Visit:

Winding our way to Fall River we'll find Battleship Cove. The home to five national historic landmarks and official veteran memorials on

both state and national levels, Battleship Cove has been providing the preservation of both the military heritage of the New England region and that of the United States since 1965.

Choice 2 After Plymouth Visit:

Cape Cod Maritime Academy along Buzzards Bay

Established in 1891 and is the second oldest state maritime academy in the United States.

The world's leading, independent non-profit organization dedicated to ocean research, exploration, and education.

Day 4: Newport RI Newport, Rhode Island

With the National Sailing Hall of Fame, Maritime Museum, Cliff Walk and beautiful downtown lined with awe inspiring vessels, this is undoubtedly a wonderful day engrained in maritime culture new and old.

In addition to maritime culture, Newport boasts beautiful coastline, delicious locally sourced seafood and plenty of opportunity to indulge in boutique shopping. Dig a little deeper and visit some of the local mansions to learn more about how the maritime history changed the culture of one of the smallest states in the US.
